Fantasy In Lights Experience 10 million twinkling lights and 2,500 acres of Christmas cheer!



Be dazzled as you journey through the seven-mile Fantasy In Lights scenic drive, where 17 brilliantly illuminated Christmas scenes make up one of National Geographic's Top 10 Light Displays in the World! Then step off the Jolly Trolley and into the Callaway Christmas Village, where a forest of twinkling lights, gigantic snowflakes and larger-than-life ornaments enchant your whole family. Stroll through a forest of picture perfect trees on Christmas Tree Lane and stop for hot chocolate, seasonal shopping and character meet-and-greets with Rudolph, Santa and more at the Christmas Market!

Day tour of the Gardens including Butterfly Center, Discovery Center, Birds of Prey Show, Memorial Chapel. Round of golf is optional (not included).



The National Infantry Museum and Soldier Center. Located at Fort Moore (formerly Fort Benning) the museum commemorates the courage of the U.S. Army's infantrymen. The museum details some 240 years of this country's military history through immersive galleries, video presentations and interactive exhibits showcasing thousands of historical artifacts. Includes two major memorials: a ¾-scale replica of the Vietnam Wall and a memorial to the Global War on Terrorism featuring the names

of all those killed in the conflict since 9/11 and a beam salvaged from the collapsed World Trade Center.



Biblical History Center. Tour a replica of a first-century Middle Eastern village depicting life as it was in ancient times. Four areas of ancient life are represented in the *Archaeological Replica Garden*: Life of the Shepherd, Life of the Farmer, Life of the Village, and Roman Theater and Market Street. This tour will leave you with a new understanding of life in Old and New Testament times. The *Biblical Life Artifacts Gallery* is an amazing opportunity to peer back across the ages to see what daily life was like in ancient times with 250 artifacts from Israel.

FDR's Little White House. Franklin Delano Roosevelt built the Little White House in 1932 while governor of New York, prior to being inaugurated as president in 1933. He first came to Warm Springs in 1924 hoping to find a cure for the infantile paralysis (polio) that had struck him in 1921. Visitors can tour FDR's home where he died in 1945 while posing for a portrait. The home has been carefully preserved very much as it was the day he died there.
